The MHSA is a standardized achievement test administered by the Maryland Department of Education. Four subject areas are tested on the MHSA, English, algebra, government and biology. The MHSA is administered intermittently throughout the students' high school years upon completion of each course.</p>	<p>Annually</p>
<p>2. Students will improve their self-concepts and motivational levels by the time they graduate from high school.</p>	<p>Acquire knowledge and skills for lifelong understanding and self-development.</p>	<p>Annually</p>
